In 2002, Glen Evans became friends with a group of undocumented immigrants from Honduras living in Arlington, Virginia. He soon realized these young men were totally cut off from their families. From his background, Glen realized the problems created when communication between family members is severed. So he decided to visit the families in Honduras. He made videos of the men here and videos of the families in Honduras allowing each to see and hear the other. Using his vacation time to make the trips, he quickly discovered the tremendous destitution of Honduras.

Poverty was nothing new to Glen. He volunteered for six years in a homeless shelter in Washington, D.C. and served as a volunteer in India. But the poverty of Honduras touched him in new ways. Glen wanted to find a practical solution to the poverty. Thus Art For Humanity was born.

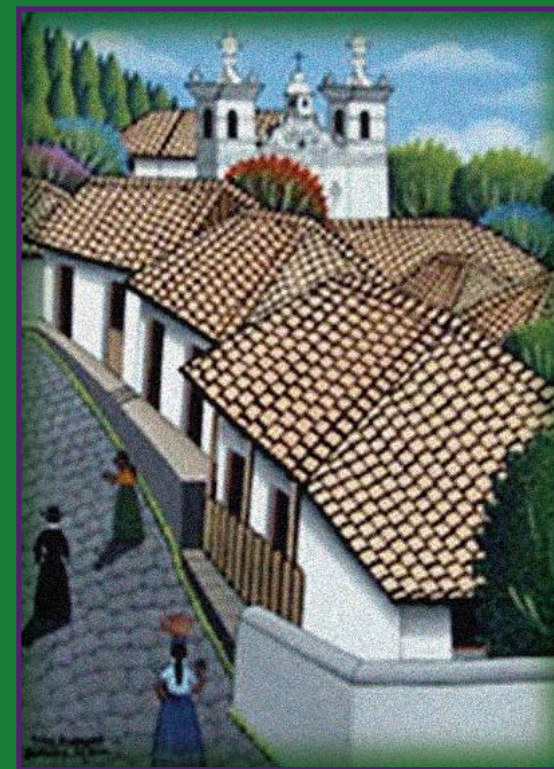
