- While there is a religious and spiritual underpinning to this organization, the primary mission of the college is education. Is that acceptable to you?
- Do you have a flexible attitude and can you be a team player?

Because you will be living in close community with others, you may be asked to submit a background check.

We also have a policy of zero tolerance for drug use or violent behavior.
